Sample Lesson (Blank)

Word: Introduce the word in context (text or oral sentence)		
Say the word in whole, then by syllables. Ask students to repeat the word a few times.

Authority: In this text, one man has *authority* over another man.

The word is authority . What is the word?

The word authority means the right or power to give orders, make decisions, or control people.	<p>The word authority can also mean a source of expert information or opinion. <i>Isabel Beck is an authority on vocabulary.</i></p> <p>Yes or No and Why?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does a teacher have authority?• Does authority need to be earned?• Can anyone become an authority? <p>Ask: Please name and describe someone that has a high degree of authority? 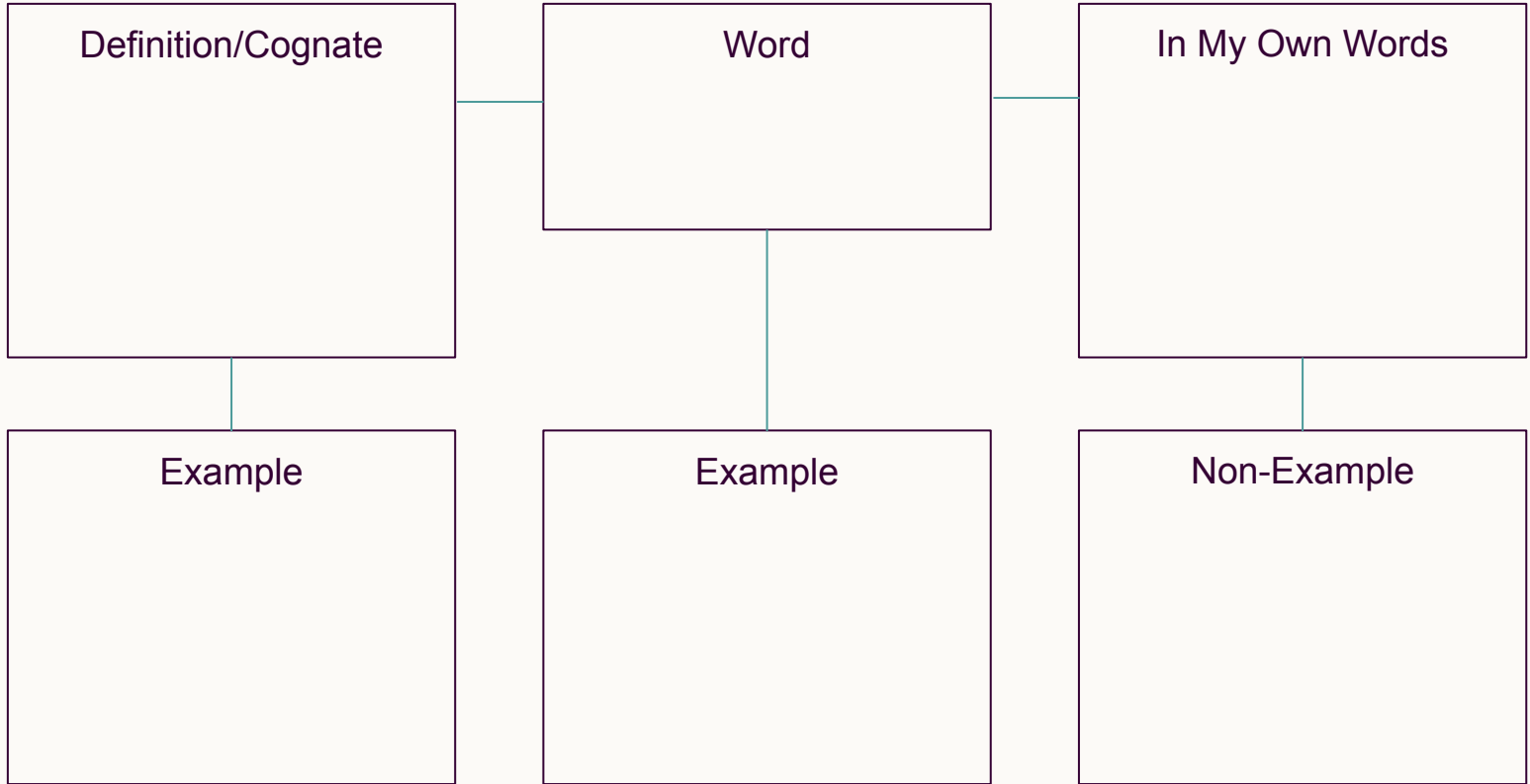

Comprehension: Close Reading Lesson Sequence

Build Background Knowledge

- Activate prior knowledge.
- Introduce key terms.
- Engage with new vocabulary using the sample lesson plan.

Read the Text: First Read

- Number the paragraphs.
- Read the text silently and annotate.
 - Use the “Click and Clunk” protocol.
 - Circle or highlight confusing words or phrases.
 - Note in the margin key details or terms.

Read the Text: Second Read

- Read along silently while the teacher reads aloud.
- Share your first impressions with your partner.
- Discuss main ideas. Use the “Get the Gist” protocol.

Read the Text: Third Read

- UNDERLINE powerful words/phrases.
- NOTE places in the text that confuse you or are unclear (mark with ?).
- NOTE places that interest or surprise you (mark with a★).
- JOT any questions you have.
- WRITE any personal connections or reactions.

- Work with a partner to answer the text-dependent questions.
